General Learning Outcomes

At the end of this course students should be able to, within the appropriate range of vocabulary and structures

- comprehend and translate narrative unfamiliar Latin text into English with the aid of the prescribed word list and understand a prepared Latin passage from Virgil
- demonstrate knowledge of prepared literary Latin passages on a given theme
- examine the wider context of prepared literary Latin

Course Content (in brief)

Literature and language will be studied by reading extracts from a variety of Roman authors, including Virgil.

Grammar, vocabulary, linguistic and stylistic devices will be studied in context.

Aspects of history, society and continuing influence of the Romans will arise from the reading and lead to individual assignments

Appeals
