Further assessment opportunities

There will be an opportunity for reassessment in Unit standard 13353 Outdoor Pursuits Activity. In this standard students have the opportunity to gain 3 credits by being practically assessed in Snowboarding in the setting of a Mountain Resort context. If a student is unable to attend this Camp they have the opportunity to gain these credits by being practically assessed in Surfing in a beach context. The prerequisite for attempting the practical aspect of this unit standard is completing and handing in all prior written assessment tasks.

The Red Cross First Aid Unit Standards 6400, 64001, 64002 have reassessment opportunities during the practical class sessions, however, if a student has less than 95% attendance she may risk failing this certificate or have to complete her assessment outside of school hours at the Red Cross Office.

Unit Standard 20146 Demonstrate basic risk management for outdoor recreation, has the scope for the teacher to gain assessment answers from students by oral questioning to back up written tasks at the teachers discretion.

On occasions when a small detail is missing in a written assignment, or a piece of a written assignment is ambiguous, the teacher may ask the student to add more material to the assignment or a “verbal” may be given to the student to clarify that the student understands the concept clearly. Explanation of what a “verbal” involves will be given in class.

Absence Authorisation

A student who is unavoidably absent from a qualifications assessment or unable to meet a scheduled submission date may apply for absence authorisation. Absence authorisation will only be given in exceptional or emergency circumstances. To apply for absence authorisation you should collect the appropriate form from the school office, fill it in and return it to your Head of Level within one week of the assessment (or due) date. The absence authorisation form must be accompanied by a medical certificate or a detailed letter of explanation from a parent/guardian.

The outcome of an application for absence authorisation may be one of:

- An extension of time, if there is evidence of partially completed work
- A further assessment opportunity
- An assessment of achievement based on alternative evidence where it exists
- The application is declined and no grade is awarded.

Appeals

Any queries about an assessment decision should be made to your class teacher when the assessment is handed back. Any formal appeals should be made, within one week of the assessed work being returned to Ms Orr, HOD Physical Education, who will investigate it further or by the Principal's Nominee, Mrs Butler. Work done

in pencil or which has 'white-out' corrections cannot be reconsidered for appeals. Appeals need to be made within one school week of receiving a result.
