Aims/General Learning Outcomes

- Develop a range of practical skills related to the care of infants and children
- Develop an understanding of children's health issues and food and nutritional requirements.
- Understand some of the cognitive, emotional and physical developmental stages of pre-school children and the importance of adequate childcare and living environments for children.

Course Content

1. **Children in NZ and Their Health.**- This topic involves investigating common childhood illnesses and immunisation as well as ways to promote children's health. Students will complete the 'Tots and Toddlers' course run by Plunket.
2. **The New Zealand Family** –The main focus of this unit is examining how care provision in a society meets the needs of a nominated group. We will be looking at the issues surrounding childcare provision in relation to the living environment and hauora/well being.
3. **Food For Children** – In this topic you will be given the opportunity to learn about the practical aspects of looking after other people's children, in particular providing food to meet their nutritional needs.
4. **A Child's World** – This topic centres on learning the value of children's play in terms of their development and on how children learn. You will learn how important resources are for play and do a unit standard that involves designing and making resources for children's play.

Appeals
