Aims/General Learning Outcomes

- This course is designed to complete Unit Standards which contribute to the National Certificate in Tourism and Travel (Introductory Skills) Level Two.
- This is a vocational course designed to prepare students for employment in the tourism and travel industry.

Course Content

1. Identify work roles in tourism and travel and their related personal and professional requirements
2. Identify and write in English for the tourism and travel industry
3. Communicate with one person in English for the tourism and travel industry
4. Demonstrate knowledge of world travel geography outside New Zealand
5. Demonstrate knowledge of tourist destinations within New Zealand
6. Perform calculations for the tourism and travel industry
7. Demonstrate knowledge of computer applications and produce text on a computer for tourism and travel

Assessment Details

Assessments against these unit standards will be carried out under controlled conditions, where controlled conditions mean that the candidate is supervised during the assessment or assessments will be assignment- based where students will be completing work both within the classroom and in their own time. Assessments may also include presentations or dialogues, in which case these will be recorded.

Appeals

Any queries about an assessment decision should be made to your class teacher when the assessment is handed back. Any formal appeals should be made, **within one week** of the assessed work being returned to the Head of Department, Mrs Franklin, or the Principal's Nominee, (Term 1 Ms Lynch, remainder of 2009, Mrs Butler), who will investigate it further.
