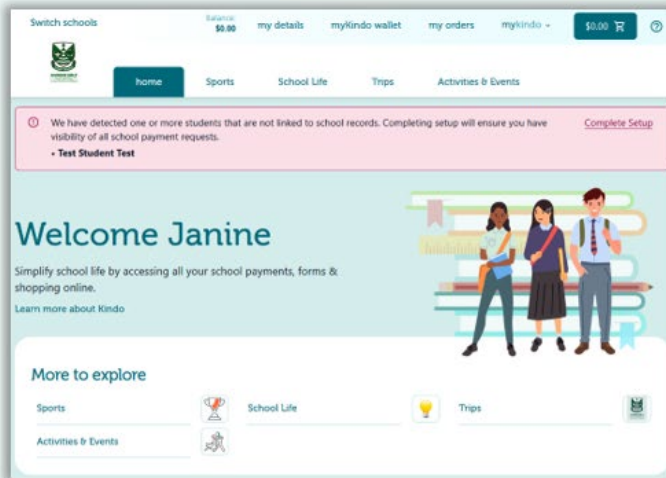

Avonside Girls' High School uses Kindo for all school payments and purchases. Kindo accepts online eftpos, credit and debit cards, Poli and bank transfer.



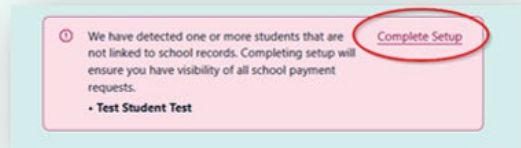
Getting started with myKindo
