

## Avonside Girls High School - Year 9 Stationery and Other Costs in 2026

Avonside Girls' High School Board of Trustees has opted into the \$150 donations scheme offered by the Government for 2026. This means our Board will not be asking parents for contributions for delivery of the curriculum, unless there is an overnight or take-home component. To ensure your daughter is well prepared for the start of the year, we suggest she has all her stationery before the school year begins.

### Common Subjects

The stationery listed below is required for your daughter's compulsory subjects and assumes that she has a personal device (computer/tablet with keyboard) for her learning. Chromebooks are not suitable for use on our network at AGHS; a laptop is recommended.

**Stationery** can be purchased from a variety of businesses including Office Max who offer an online purchasing option which will also deliver to your home.


To ensure your daughter is well prepared for the start of the 2026 school year, we suggest she has all her stationery by 26<sup>th</sup> January 2026.

**Possible additional costs:** If there is a take-home component as part of the learning, payment for the cost of materials used is required. This will be advised in writing in 2026. Sports and all other extra curricular activities are chargeable.

**AGHS Student ID Card – ID/Print card** A student ID card is a non-curriculum related expense. Students’ individual photos taken on school photo day will be sent to produce individualised cards. Information on ordering cards will be given at the start of the year. Cards will cost \$10 including GST.

Avonside Girls’ High School uses Kindo for all school payments and purchases. Kindo accepts online eftpos, credit and debit cards, Poli and bank transfer.






### Getting started with myKindo
